

LITERARY MONSTERS

Our show, Literary Monsters, is part concert, part puppet show, and part ghost story. It is a 50-minute performance that reimagines the monsters of gothic literature and pop culture through a queer lens and attempts to answer the question, "What is a monster?"

The audience views the shadow puppetry on a screen while they watch puppeteers create the magic on overhead projectors and on a moving panorama, or "crankie." We follow the show with a Q&A and an opportunity for audience members to see the puppets and effects up close.


